Clone: TB5

Specificity:

The antibody TB5 reacts with CD162, a 220 kDa type I integral membrane protein expressed as disulfide-linked homodimer (sialomucin family). CD162 is present on the most peripheral blood T lymphocytes, monocytes, granulocytes; it is also expressed on a subpopulation of B lyphocytes and CD34⁺ bone marrow cells.

Isotype subclass: Mouse IgG1

Form:

Purified from hybridoma culture supernatant by protein A-affinity chromatography.

Purity: > 95% (by SDS-PAGE)

Physical state: Liquid

Buffer/Additives/Preservative:

PBS containing 15 mM sodium azide (pH 7.4).

Expiration date:

The reagent is stable until the expiry date stated on the vial label.

Storage conditions:

Store at 4 °C. For long-term storage aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
