Specificity:

The antibody LT19 reacts with CD19 (B4), a 95 kDa type I transmembrane glycoprotein (immunoglobulin superfamily) expressed on B lymphocytes and follicular dendritic cells; it is lost on plasma cells.

Immunogen: Daudi human Burkitt lymphoma cell line

Isotype subclass: Mouse IgG1

Form:

The purified antibody is conjugated with Fluoresceinisothiocyanate (FITC) under optimum conditions. The conjugate is purified by size-exclusion chromatography and adjusted for direct use. No reconstitution is necessary

Physical state: Liquid

Buffer/Additives/Preservative:

PBS containing BSA and 15 mM sodium azide (pH 7.4)

Expiration date:

The reagent is stable until the expiry date stated on the vial label.

Storage conditions:

Store at 4 °C. Do not freeze. Avoid prolonged exposure to light.

Application:

The reagent is designed for flow cytometry analysis
