Specificity:

The antibody MEM-78 reacts with CD10 antigen (CALLA- Common Acute Lymphatic Leukemia Antigen), a 100 kDa type II integral membrane protein expressed on uncommitted lymphoid precursors. It is also expressed on activated and proliferating B lymphocytes in the germinal centers and granulocytes.

Immunogen: mouse NALM-6 leukemia pre-B cell line (tissue/cell preparation)

Isotype subclass: Mouse IgG1

Form:

The purified antibody is conjugated with Fluoresceinisothiocyanate (FITC) under optimum conditions. The reagent is free of unconjugated FITC and adjusted for direct use. No reconstitution is necessary.

Physical state: Liquid

Buffer/Additives/Preservative:

PBS containing BSA and 0.09 % sodium azide (pH 7.4).

Expiration date:

The reagent is stable until the expiry date stated on the vial label.

Storage conditions:

Store at 4 °C. Do not freeze. Avoid prolonged exposure to light.

Application:

The reagent is designed for Flow Cytometry analysis of human blood cells.
